When I got the news I was heading to Haines Alaska on a work assignment, I jumped on the net to find my hotels, res-

taurants, and of course to see if there were any brewpubs. There wasn't, and a co worker passing by who saw what I was doing said; "Haines is only the size of Granite Falls, I'm not surprised there is no brewery." Well shortly after my arrival I was talking beer with a local, (go figure) and he told me that there was a brewery in Haines, so I headed there the first chance I got. Upon arri-

val I met Paul the brewer/ owner, he informed me that he could sell beer to go,

but could not sell beer to be consumed on the premises, "well", I said, "how about a sample?" He quickly agreed, and proceeded to sample me from lightest to darkest and beyond. As it turns out, he was as happy to talk to me about beer, as I was to glean information from a pro. There is not a lot of brewing action in Haines Alaska since Haines is only accessible by plane, boat, or through Canada, it is remote. Here

is a man who was home brewing, and decided to make a go at the big time.

A year into it and it looks like Haines is supporting this brewery, and according to Paul the future looks good and he already

has plans for expansion. All of the Haines brews are very drinkable with several styles available, pale ale, amber, I.P.A., stout and "eagle release" and a brown, (not nut brown), that is light on the pallet, and seems to be a crowd pleaser. I asked what eagle release meant and was informed that every year at a local eagle festival, one or more bald eagles are released back into the wild. I

was there just after the festival but still saw hundreds of bald eagles on the

river banks.

I purchased a growler (\$7.00) of the nicely balanced I.P.A and brought it home with me.


(Delicious)! I also have to comment on the "lookout
